



2010 GOLF CART REGULATIONS and OPERATOR PERMIT APPLICATION

The information listed within provides guidance regarding the valid usage of golf cart-type vehicles; hereinafter referred to as golf carts, at Eldora Speedway and the process to be followed to secure the required Operating Permit. Operators of golf carts understand that they do so at their own risk, and will relieve and hold harmless Eldora Speedway, Inc. for any and all debts that might occur from theft, accidents and/or injuries involving the use of the golf cart. These regulations have been designed to provide a safe and friendly environment for all persons attending events at Eldora Speedway. Thank you for your cooperation.

2010 Golf Cart Rules and Regulations

Darke County Sheriff Toby Spencer issues this reminder -

Ohio Revised Code 4519.40 PROHIBITS golf carts from being on ANY public roadways at ANY time. Violators will be cited, fined and be subject to 3 days in jail.

A. GENERAL RULES

1. All golf carts on Eldora Speedway property must prominently display an official 2010 Eldora Speedway Golf Cart Permit at all times.
2. The Operator Permit Application must be filed, and paid for, in person, with the golf cart present.
3. The \$25 non-transferable Operator Permit is issued on an annual basis. Permits that have been altered or tampered with shall be void.
4. Operators must hold a valid drivers license.
5. Golf carts intended to be used after dark shall be equipped with headlights or other sufficient lighting sources.
6. Golf carts may not be operated during designated 'quiet times' **as announced by Eldora Speedway officials.**

B. OPERATION OF GOLF CART

1. Golf carts are not to be operated in a manner that may endanger passengers and/or any other patrons on the grounds of Eldora Speedway. Excessive speeds will not be tolerated. Operators must yield to pedestrians at all times.
2. **STATE LAW - OPEN** alcoholic beverages are not permitted in any golf cart. No one under the influence of alcohol may operate a golf cart.
3. Golf carts are not to be overloaded, i.e. carrying more passengers than for the seating provided.
4. Golf carts are restricted to the designated driveways and paths within the parking lots of Eldora Speedway. There shall be no driving on any public roadways, landscaping, etc. Golf carts may not be chained to any trees, signposts, etc.. **NO DRIVING ON THE RACE TRACK!**

C. PARKING REGULATIONS

1. Golf carts can only be parked within areas designated by proper signage and/or as announced over the Eldora Speedway public address system.
2. Golf carts must be parked within these areas in such a fashion that they do not block or impede entrance to buildings, stairways or designated handicapped areas.

Violation of these regulations will result in the golf cart being impounded for the remainder of the event, revocation of the Operating Permit and possible expulsion of the operator from the property, with NO REFUND.
