THURSDAY & FRIDAY (\$52,800 posted each night):

MULTI-CAR GROUP QUALIFYING – Each night, multi-car group qualifying, using groups determined by random draw at Inspection, will be used to determine that group's Heat Race lineup. The driver's fastest time from Thursday and Friday will be used as a tiebreaker, if necessary, for Saturday's lineups. There are two time trial-based positions in the World 100 (see provisionals).

HEAT RACES – The preliminary format plans for up to 12 Heat Races of 8 laps in distance. The inversion procedure will be detailed at the Driver Meeting.
