

2016 GOLF CART REGULATIONS and OPERATOR PERMIT APPLICATION

The information listed within provides guidance regarding the valid usage of golf cart-type vehicles; hereinafter referred to as golf carts, at Eldora Speedway and the process to be followed to secure the required Operating Permit. Operators of golf carts understand that they do so at their own risk, and will relieve and hold harmless Eldora Speedway, Inc. for any and all debts that might occur from theft, accidents and/or injuries involving the use of the golf cart. These regulations have been designed to provide a safe and friendly environment for all persons attending events at Eldora Speedway. No ATVs, bar stools, coolers, dirt bikes, mopeds, scooters, side x sides, tractors, utility ATVs, or similar permitted. Thank you for your cooperation.

2016 Golf Cart Rules and Regulations

The Darke County Sheriff Office issues this reminder - Ohio Revised Code 4519.40 PROHIBITS golf carts from being on ANY public roadways at ANY time. Violators will be cited, fined and be subject to 3 days in jail.

A. GENERAL RULES

- 1. <u>All</u> golf carts on Eldora property must prominently display an official 2016 Eldora Speedway Golf Cart Permit on left front of unit at all times.
- 2. The Operator Permit Application must be filed, and paid for, in person, with the golf cart present.
- 3. The \$25 *non-transferable* Operator Permit is issued on an annual basis. Permits that have been altered or tampered with shall be void.
- 4. Operators must hold a valid driver's license.
- 5. Headlights or sufficient lighting required after dark.
- 6. Golf carts may not be operated during designated 'quiet times' (one hour after racing 6:30 a.m.).

B. OPERATION OF GOLF CART

- 1. Golf carts are not to be operated in a manner that may endanger passengers and/or any other patrons on the grounds of Eldora. Excessive speeds will not be tolerated, limit to walking speed. Operators must yield to pedestrians at all times.
- 2. **STATE LAW OPEN** alcoholic containers are not permitted in any golf cart. No one under the influence of alcohol may operate a golf cart per Ohio Revised Code 4511.19.
- 3. Golf carts are not to be overloaded, i.e. carrying more passengers than for the seating provided. No hanging or standing.
- 4. Golf carts are restricted to the designated driveways and paths within the parking lots of Eldora Speedway. There shall be no driving on any public roadways, landscaping, etc. Golf carts may not be chained to any trees, signposts, etc... NO DRIVING ON THE RACE TRACK!

C. PARKING REGULATIONS

- 1. Golf carts can only be parked within areas designated by proper signage and/or as announced over the Eldora Speedway public address system.
- 2. Golf carts must be parked within these areas in such a fashion that they do not block or impede entrance to buildings, stairways or designated handicapped areas.

Any violation of these regulations will result in the golf cart being impounded for the remainder of the event, revocation of the Operating Permit and possible expulsion of the operator from the property, with NO REFUND. ELDORA SPEEDWAY IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENTS-INJURIES-THEFT ASSOCIATED
