This race program is sanctioned by DIRTcar Racing (DIRTcar) and will be run under its mechanical, safety, and technical rules and regulations. In signing an Official Entry Form (OEF) or taking part in any of the events described in the OEF, all competitors acknowledge that they have received, read, and understand all DIRTcar rules and regulations associated with the event, and hereby agree to abide by all official DIRTcar decisions and regulations.

EVERY LAP MATTERS™ FORMAT

When competitors are on track during Wednesday and Friday's Twin 25 Qualifying Preliminary Nights, they will be scoring points using Eldora's Every Lap Matters™ format to seed the Heat Race lineups for the 51st #World100 on Thursday night and the 50th #World100 on Saturday night. There are two provisional starting positions, 19th and 20th, in each of the 100-lap Championship Features awarded to the two drivers highest in the applicable preliminary night standings who do not advance from the Heat Races.

Multi-Car Qualifying: the field will be split into two groups for Multi-Car Qualifying (Group A & Group B). Each group earns points separately for their results – 1st) 100; 2nd) 94; 3rd) 91; 4th) 88; 5th) 85; 6th) 82; 7th) 79; 8th) 76; 9th) 73; 10th) 70; 11th) 67; 12th) 64; 13th) 62; 14th) 60; 15th) 58; 16th) 56; 17th) 54; 18th) 52; 19th) 50; 20th) 48; 21st) 46; 22nd) 44; 23rd) 43; and 24th through field) decreases by 1 point.

Heat Races: 1st) 200; 2nd) 195; 3rd) 192; 4th) 189; 5th) 186; 6th) 183; 7th) 180; 8th) 177; 9th) 174; 10th) 171; 11th) 168; 12th) 165; 13th) 163; and 14th through field) decreases by 2 points.

Last Chance Showdowns: first 10 cars not advancing from any LCS) 235; 233; 231; 229; 227; 225; 223; 221; 219; 217; and balance of field decreases by 1 point.

A-Features: 1st) 300; 2nd) 296; 3rd) 293; 4th) 290; 5th) 287; 6th) 284; 7th) 281; 8th) 278; 9th) 275; 10th) 272; 11th) 269; 12th) 266; 13th) 264; 14th) 262; 15th) 260; 16th) 258; 17th) 256; 18th) 254; 19th) 252; 20th) 250; 21st) 248; 22nd) 246; 23rd) 244; and 24th) 242.

The original green flag must be taken on the track to score points in any Time Trial, Heat Race, Last Chance Showdown or A-Feature contest. Drivers not making a qualification attempt, late to qualifying, and/or not starting any scheduled race will score ZERO points for that portion of the program. *A three position/one group grace MAY be granted during time trials at the discretion of the officials, however, drivers missing their drawn position/group cannot start better than the inverted cars in their Heat Race regardless of their best-timed lap.*

1. Minimum age for competitors is 16 years of age as of September 8th, 2021. Only persons 14 years of age or older will be admitted to pit area. Minors 14, 15, 16 or 17 years of age must submit a Parental Consent, Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement/Minor's Assumption of Risk and Release and Waiver of Liability signed by BOTH of their parents (or legal guardians). No exceptions. [Click Here for Minor Waivers](#). See driver registration site for "MVP Driver/Owner Minor Vest Program." Pit rules enforced.

2. One entry per driver per event. The primary car will be sealed at Inspection & Registration. Backup cars are permitted but penalized to the tail of the next subsequent race (Heat Race, LCS/B-Feature or Feature race) for which the driver has qualified. The driver's Every Lap Matters™ points are retained.

If a team requests to use a backup car, the primary car is officially withdrawn and cannot be used again in the event. NOTE: Due to the unique nature of the "Double World" format, the 51st World 100 on Sept 8th & 9th is considered a separate event from the 50th World 100 on Sept 10th & 11th. Example: A car withdrawn from the Wednesday/Thursday show may be repaired and used in competition during the Friday/Saturday show.

All cars will be subject to Eldora/DIRTcar control from the time they enter the pit area until officially released after the event.

3. Only tow vehicles are allowed inside pit area. ONE work area vehicle (ATV, Pit Cart or similar – no sport or trail-style vehicles) per entry, may be presented for credentialing at Registration – NO RIDERS PERMITTED UNLESS A SECOND SEAT EXISTS – work area vehicles must remain within the pit area gates, may be used only at specified times, and may not be used on unrestricted areas of property. Please cooperate with these rules so that we may continue to offer this courtesy.
4. All drivers are required to participate in “Meet & Greet” and/or autograph sessions.
5. It is strongly encouraged that the driver’s last name be clearly displayed in BOLD BLOCK LETTERS on both doors and across front of roof.
6. A Racing Electronics Solo or “raceceiver-style” one-way radio (listening only to 454.000) and an AMB scoring transponder is mandatory for ALL on-track activity. You may use your own AMB scoring transponder, or one will be assigned to you from the World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Series Command Center.
7. All races will start and restart double-file in their entirety EIRI. The Start/Restart Zone and procedures will be detailed at driver meeting. All green flags must be taken on-track at the start/finish line.
8. All prize money will be mailed from Eldora to designee. Checks will not be issued without a verified IRS Form W-9 (or W-8BEN for Canadian entrants) on file. All entrants are participating on their own behalf and are completely independent of the event promoter. As an independent contractor, entrants are responsible for prize money received including all income and withholding taxes that apply to such winnings.
9. Eldora Speedway, Inc. reserves the right to alter show format and revise race procedures due, but not limited, to: car count; inclement weather; challenging track conditions; and/or other extenuating circumstances. DIRTcar will enforce and govern all mechanical, technical and tire regulations and rules. Mechanical, technical and tire infractions may result in a complete loss of all prize money earned. Eldora reserves right to refuse any entry and/or remove any person from Speedway property.

VP Race Fuels, provided by River Cities Speed Shop, will be available at the fuel pumps in the Upper Pit Area until 30 minutes prior to track activity.

SHANE UNGER MEMORIAL ROOKIE AWARDS (\$7,000 posted)

Drivers attempting the #World100 for the first-time are eligible for the “Rookie of the Race” program.

Wednesday & Friday – Top-Three Rookies by Points (\$1,000 posted per night): The top-three performing rookie drivers in each of the Thursday and Friday programs, ranked by total points for the night, will be awarded: **1) \$500;** 2) \$300 & 3) \$200.

Wednesday & Friday – Best Finish by a Rookie (\$1,000 posted): The rookie driver with the best overall finish on Wednesday and Friday will be awarded: **1) \$500.**

51st World 100 – Rookie of the Race (\$2,000): The highest finishing rookie driver in the 51st World 100 on Thursday, Sept 9th will be awarded: **1) \$2,000.**

50th World 100 – Rookie of the Race (\$2,000): The highest finishing rookie driver in the 50th World 100 on Saturday, Sept 11th will be awarded: **1) \$2,000.**

EVERY LAP MATTERS™ POINT AWARDS (\$10,000 posted)

Wednesday & Friday (\$2,500 posted per night): The top-three performing drivers in the Wednesday and Friday programs, ranked by total points for the night, will be awarded: **1) \$1,250;** 2) \$750 & 3) \$500.

Total Points Overall (\$5,000 posted): The top-three performing drivers in accumulated points after the two preliminary programs will be awarded: **1) \$2,500;** 2) \$1,500 & 3) \$1,000.

ADVANCEMENT, FORMAT & POSTED AWARDS

– Subject to Change and Adjustment for Final Roster, Weather and/or Track Conditions –

TWIN 25 QUALIFYING NIGHTS (WEDNESDAY & FRIDAY)

MULTI-CAR QUALIFYING – On Wednesday and Friday, after the random draw is split into Group A and Group B, Multi-Car Qualifying, using flights determined by the random draw at Inspection & Registration, will be used to seed the Heat Race lineups in staggered fashion.

A driver's fastest time from Wednesday will be used as a tiebreaker, if necessary, for Thursday's lineups. Accordingly, a driver's fastest time from Friday will be used as a tiebreaker, if necessary, for Saturday's lineups.

If weather interrupts Multi-Car Qualifying, the Group's Heat Race lineups will be determined by their Timed Hot Laps.

HEAT RACES – The preliminary show format plans for four Heat Races of 10-laps in distance for each of Group A and Group B. The invert for the Heat Races will be the number of cars advancing less one (ex. four heats advance five cars = invert four). Cars finishing 1st through 5th advance into their group's Twin 25 A-Feature and the balance of the finishers will advance into one of the Last Chance Showdowns. Group A will contest Heats 1 through 4 to determine the first Twin 25 A-Feature. The cars not advancing will contest the first half of the Last Chance Showdowns. Group B will contest Heats 5 through 8 to determine the second Twin 25 A-Feature. The Group B cars not advancing will contest the second half of the Last Chance Showdowns.

LAST CHANCE SHOWDOWNS (\$22,000) – On each Twin 25 Qualifying Night, Last Chance Showdowns of 12 laps in distance will be contested. Assuming four Last Chance Showdowns, cars finishing 1st and 2nd will advance to their respective A-Feature. All other starters will receive \$125.

TWIN 25 LAP A-FEATURES (\$203,200 posted) – Each preliminary night will run two A-Features of 25-laps, starting 24 cars. Assuming five cars advance from the Heat Races, starting positions 1st

through 10th will consist of the cars finishing 1st and 2nd in the Heat Races, plus the two fastest 3rd place finishers as determined by multi-car qualifying. The top-10 will then be inverted, slowest to fastest, by qualifying time. Starting positions 11th through 20th will be lined up by Heat Race finish. Starting positions 21 through 24 will be lined up by Last Chance Showdown finish. Prize money will be distributed to finishing positions as follows:

FRIDAY (two Features, each paying): 1st) \$10,000; 2nd) 6,000; 3rd) 3,500; 4th) 2,800; 5th) 2,500; 6th) 2,300; 7th) 2,200; 8th) 2,100; 9th) 2,050; 10th) 2,000; 11th) 1,600; 12th) 1,400; 13th) 1,200; 14th) 1,100; 15th) 1,050; 16th) 1,000; 17th) 1,000; 18th) 1,000; 19th) 1,000; 20th) 1,000; 21st) 1,000; 22nd) 1,000; 23rd) 1,000; and 24th) 1,000.

51st & 50th running of the WORLD 100 (Thurs. & Sat. – \$521,100 Prize Money & Awards)

HEAT RACES (\$42,000 posted) – Each of the World 100s will feature six Heat Races of 15-laps in distance. The pre-invert lineups will be established in staggered fashion using the Every Lap Matters™ standings. The tiebreakers are: 1) best finish from applicable Preliminary Night; 2) fastest time from applicable Preliminary Night; 3) order in which Official Entry Form is received online – timestamp required by 11:59 p.m. Eastern on Monday, Sept 6th). The inversion, up to six cars, will be determined randomly by the Wheel of Misfortune. Cars finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the Heat Races advance to the #World100s, while cars finishing 4th-11th advance to one of two B-Features, in order of finishing position. Heats 1-2-3 will determine B-Feature #1 and Heats 4-5-6 will determine B-Feature #2.

Prize money for the Heat Races will be distributed as follows: non-advancing cars receive **\$250**.

PROVISIONALS (TWO) – The two highest point drivers in Every Lap Matters™ standings who do not advance from their Heat Races, will start 19th and 20th in the #World100s on Thursday and Saturday (if qualified for a B-Feature, the Heat Race results are adjusted).

B-FEATURES & B-SCRAMBLES (\$67,900 posted) – Each of the #World100s will have two B-Features of 20-laps in distance. Cars finishing 1st through 3rd in each will advance to the #World100s.

The remaining B-Feature cars will restart in their running order for the B-Scramble of 5-laps in distance. The winner of each B-Scramble will advance to the #World100s. Prize money for the B-Scramble will be distributed as follows: 2nd) **\$1,500**; 3rd) 975; 4th) 950; 5th) 925; 6th) 900; 7th through 14th) 800; 15th – 20th) 750.

51st & 50th World 100s (\$407,100 Prize money & Awards) – The Championship Events will be 100 green flag laps in distance starting 28 cars each. Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)
- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)

- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
 - Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
 - Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)
- Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding? on page 2.

By signing the filled-out form, you:
