ELDORA SPEEDWAY HAS BEEN RESURFACED WITH ALL NEW DIRT

<u>THE SOURCE IS APPROX. ONE-MILE AWAY – THE MATERIAL IS SIMILAR TO THAT USED PRIOR TO 2005</u> ***<u>TIRE RULES FOR THE ELDORA MILLION, DLM DREAM, & WORLD 100 HAVE NOT YET BEEN SET</u>***

After consultation with our partners at Hoosier Tire and Hoosier Tire Midwest, Eldora Speedway, FloRacing Night in America, and DIRTcar Racing officials have adopted the following tire rule to best accommodate Hoosier's available supply, competitor inventory, and the differences in the composition of the new surface.

QUALIFYING, HEAT RACES, & B-FEATURES

All entrants must use the same four tires for each of Qualifying Time Trials, Heat Races, and the B-Feature (except in rare instances – EIRI):

POSITIONS AND COMPOUNDS

LF – LM90/11-15 M20 RF – LM90/11-15 M20 LR – LM90/11-15 M20 RR – LM92/11-15 M30s

Tires may be buffed, grooved, sanded, and siped

Alteration of the factory compound from the manufacturer is prohibited and will be enforced per the DIRTcar rulebook

EIRI – Damaged or punctured tires may only be replaced with approval of the designated official. Replacement tire penalties will be addressed at the driver meeting.

A-FEATURE

Entrants may change up to three tires for the A-Feature:

POSITIONS AND COMPOUNDS

LF – LM90/11-15 M20 or M30s LR – LM90/11-15 M20 or M30s RF – LM90/11-15 M20 or M30s RR – LM92/11-15 M30s or M40

Tires may be buffed, grooved, sanded, and siped

Alteration of the factory compound from the manufacturer is prohibited and will be enforced per the DIRTcar rulebook

Per Eldora track rules, there are no courtesy laps for flat tires and series/track officials do not pull fenders (EIRI). Intentionally causing a yellow flag when a tire is not flat will be a one-lap penalty.

<u>PIT ROAD & STAGING AREA</u>: Any car that has crew members ride, mount or manipulate the car between Tire Tech and the Staging Area – marked by the yellow line painted on pit road – or has crew members ride, mount or manipulate the car when staged is subject to penalty by Eldora Speedway and DIRTcar officials on the first offense. A second offense will result in disqualification.

No fueling of any kind is permitted in staging.

Any car violating Pit Road and Staging Area rules forfeits their original starting position. The penalty will be no less than starting at the back of the longest line for the original start.

Repeat offenses will be penalized accordingly.
